Economic Literacy Projects

Youth Entrepreneurship/Leadership Camp

Work with youth in a fun camp setting to share basic knowledge of economic and business concepts, and to enable youth to showcase and develop their own entrepreneurial leadership and potential through development of a business venture.



Job Skills Workshops

Train adults to find employment by sharing skills such as interviewing, resume building, dressing for success, and reference development. Work with employed adults to develop computer skills, supervisory skills, and more.
