Support programs that advance the social and economic well-being of people and build capacity for local organizations and professionals to meet the needs of their communities.



Human Rights Projects

Develop a culture of human rights by working with industry to improve conditions for workers; collaborating with lawyers and public officials to increase advocacy efforts for sexual assault victims; providing training to support the work of human rights organizations; or establishing legal aid clinics or victim service centers.



Women's Rights and Economic Opportunity

Programs seek to impact issues such as domestic violence and equality by working with women to increase economic opportunities. Through education and job opportunity, women are more able to provide for themselves and their children.



Youth Development Programs

Work with youth to develop knowledge of the country's government and law, and how to be involved as leaders in making a positive difference in the region. Encourage and empower youth to claim their own rights and serve as advocates for the rights of others by providing youth with opportunities and training to enhance their ability to take action on pressing human rights issues.



Legal Support Projects

Provide legal expertise, advice, research, analysis, and training to judges, lawyers and government officials. Work with local lawyers and governments to assist with the development and/or reform of legal and governmental processes.
